A need was felt for imparting management skills to officers of all three services in a joint environment. Accordingly, a decision was taken during the Joint Operations Logistics Committee mtg held at HQ IDS on 23 Jan 08 to conduct a Joint Logistics Capsule Course (JLCC) at College of Defence Management. Since the course focuses on promoting jointmanship and ensuring effective management of scarce resources in a tri-services environment, the course was renamed as Joint Resource Management Course (JRMC) in 2014. It is a two weeks course conducted once every year.

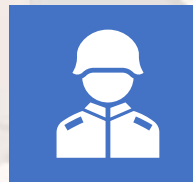
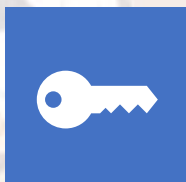
Aim
