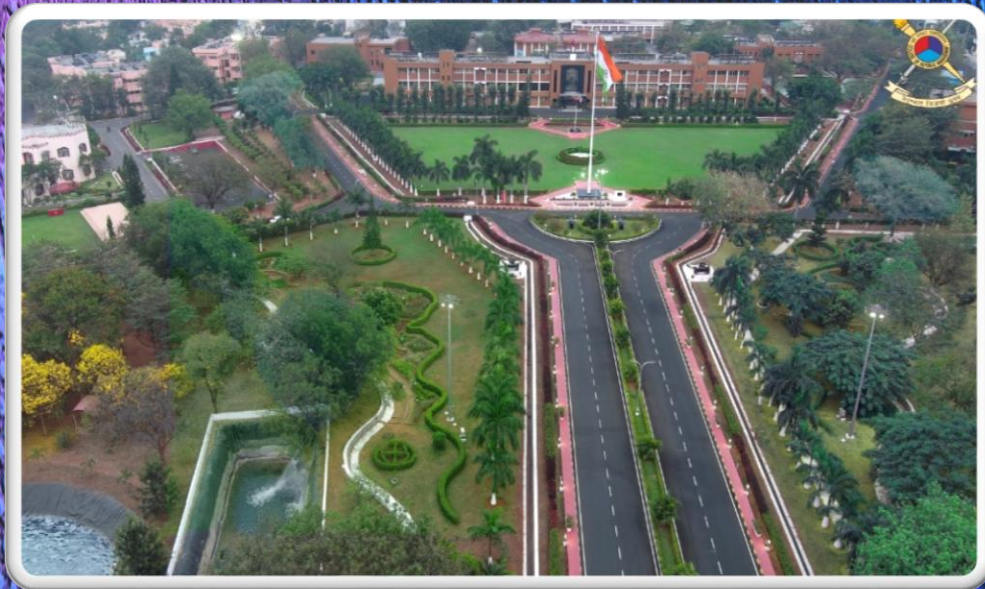




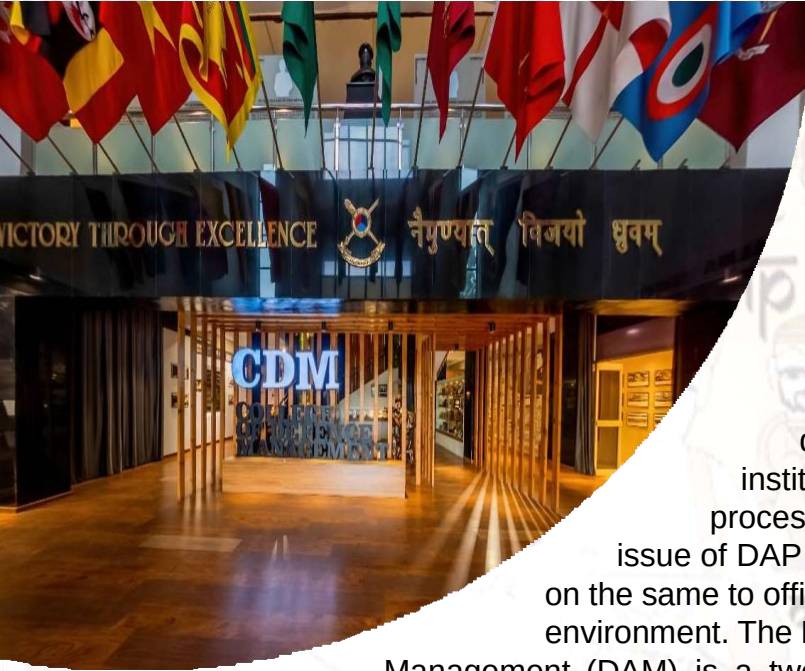

To develop qualified 'Acquisition Professionals' who can deliver and sustain efficient and responsive value chains towards planned defence capability build up.

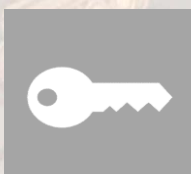
